[PROPOSED] ORDER

Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment or, in the Alternative, for Summary Adjudication came on for hearing on March 24, 2022. The Court has considered the evidence and arguments of the parties.

After full consideration of the evidence, separate statements, and the authorities submitted by counsel, as well as counsel's oral argument, the Court finds there is no triable issue of material fact, and Plaintiffs are entitled to judgment as a matter of law for the following reasons:

- 1. Councilmember Oscar de la Torre has no *personal* interest in *Pico Neighborhood*Association, et al. v. City of Santa Monica. Rather, the relief sought, and awarded, in that case affects substantially every voter in Santa Monica.
- 2. Councilmember Oscar de la Torre, therefore, has no conflict of interest.
- 3. Defendant's evidence of Councilmember de la Torre's relationships with the plaintiffs in *Pico Neighborhood Association, et al. v. City of Santa Monica* is not a substitute for a personal interest;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the said motion for summary judgment is GRANTED and that judgment shall be entered forthwith in favor of Plaintiffs and against Defendant.
