CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

The conditions, surroundings and arrangements for the operation(s) or activities subject to this permit shall be in accordance with all applicable regulations. The permit is subject to revocation for failure to comply with those regulations and any specific conditions that are in effect at the time of inspection.

In obtaining a fire department permit the applicant understands and acknowledges that Santa Monica Fire Department has the right to enter and inspect that for which the permit is issued for compliance with the rules and regulations enforced by the City of Santa Monica. The applicant acknowledges that right and agrees to pay all costs incurred by the City of Santa Monica in securing any judicial writ or inspection warrant to fulfill that right wherein the applicant fails to give consent for inspection. Said costs shall include all personnel time and court costs incurred by the City of Santa Monica to procure any judicial writ or inspection warrant.

Application is made to the Santa Monica Fire Department for inspection and approval of the described operation or activity, which will conform to all applicable standards. No operation or activity requiring a permit will be performed until a Fire Department permit is received. We understand working without approved plans and a permit will result in delays and additional fees.
