Emily gave an overview of the summer reading program for adults and children, reading prizes and activities, new features for logging of reading minutes via Beanstack; and Santa Monica Reads all summer through One Book, One County, a community reading program.

- b. Presentation of Teen Services

Gia gave an overview of the restoration of the teen volunteer program and development of a Teen Council. The program has a total of 38 teen volunteers. Gia shared the importance of teen volunteers in the library, attending programs, providing an education place to provide essential volunteer opportunities, while learning to contribute to their community. Teen Council has been able to help hold teen programs and create initiatives. A recent initiative includes the launching of a literary magazine, and writing take and make kits.
