

The Bergamot Area First-Last Mile Improvements project is well underway, and components are already taking shape in the community. Thank you for your patience during construction.

Coming soon, a flashing yellow arrow signal and signage will be installed at 26th Street and Olympic Boulevard in mid-January 2025.

A flashing yellow arrow means that vehicles can cautiously make the turn indicated by the arrow, but they must first YIELD to oncoming traffic, pedestrians, bicyclists, and scooter users. Flashing yellow arrows can reduce crashes by up to 20% according to a recent Federal Highway Administration study. Compared to a traditional green light, drivers make fewer mistakes with flashing yellow arrows and they also move traffic more efficiently.

The following intersections will also receive a flashing yellow arrow signal and signage:

- Wilshire Blvd/16th St anticipated 2025
- Olympic Blvd/Stewart St anticipated 2026
- Colorado Ave/Stewart St anticipated 2026
- 26th St/Pennsylvania Ave- anticipated 2026

WHAT DO THE ARROWS MEAN?



SOLID RED ARROW Users intending to turn at an intersection must stop and wait. They should not enter an intersection to turn when a solid red arrow is displayed.



SOLID YELLOW ARROW The turn signal is about to change to red and users should prepare to stop or prepare to complete a turn if they are legally within the intersection and there is no conflicting traffic present.



FLASHING YELLOW ARROW Users are allowed to turn after yielding to all oncoming traffic including pedestrians or bicyclists in the crosswalk.



SOLID GREEN ARROW Those turning have the right-of-way. Oncoming traffic has a red light._
