
NOTICE OF CROSSWALK REMOVAL

Starting in Fall 2024, construction will begin to remove the crosswalk across Colorado Avenue leading to Yale Street.

CROSSWALK REMOVAL

The existing crosswalk across Colorado Avenue leading to Yale Street will be removed to reduce conflicts across all travel modes. The existing turn lane lacks adequate storage space for turning vehicles, leading to an increase in rear-ends, sideswipes, and failure to yield.



NO LEFT TURN ONTO YALE STREET, BIKES EXEMPT

As part of the improvements, left turns onto Yale Street will be prohibited for vehicles. The existing left turn lane will be converted to a left turn bike lane. This will create a seamless connection for bicyclists and facilitate better traffic flow.



3 PARKING REMOVAL

Four parking spaces on the north side of Colorado Avenue from Stewart Street to Yale Street will be removed to create space for a protected bike lane on Colorado Avenue.

WHY THE CHANGE

This change is part of the Bergamot Area Improvement project along Stewart Street and Pennsylvania Avenue to enhance pedestrian and cyclist safety and access.

Other improvements include:

- · A resurfaced street for a smooth ride
- ·Sidewalks, trees, and lighting
- ·Bicycle signals
- ·Protected bike lanes
- ·Bus boarding islands

This project is partially funded with Measure M tax dollars.
