SANTA MONICA BLVD SAFETY STUDY

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Santa Monica Blvd is a vital street in our city that links key community and regional destinations including the Santa Monica Public Library, Santa Monica College Performing Arts Center, hospitals, and schools. In 2022, the City completed a Local Roadway Safety Plan, expanding on the Vision Zero initiative from 2017, with the goal of eliminating fatal and severe crashes. Both of these studies identified Santa Monica Blvd as a priority street, due to its high number and severity of crashes.

The Santa Monica Blvd Safety Study is now seeking feedback from the community on their experience when traveling through Santa Monica Blvd, especially when it comes to traffic safety, speeding, and congestion. The final product will include design recommendations to improve safety for people walking, rolling, driving, and taking transit.
