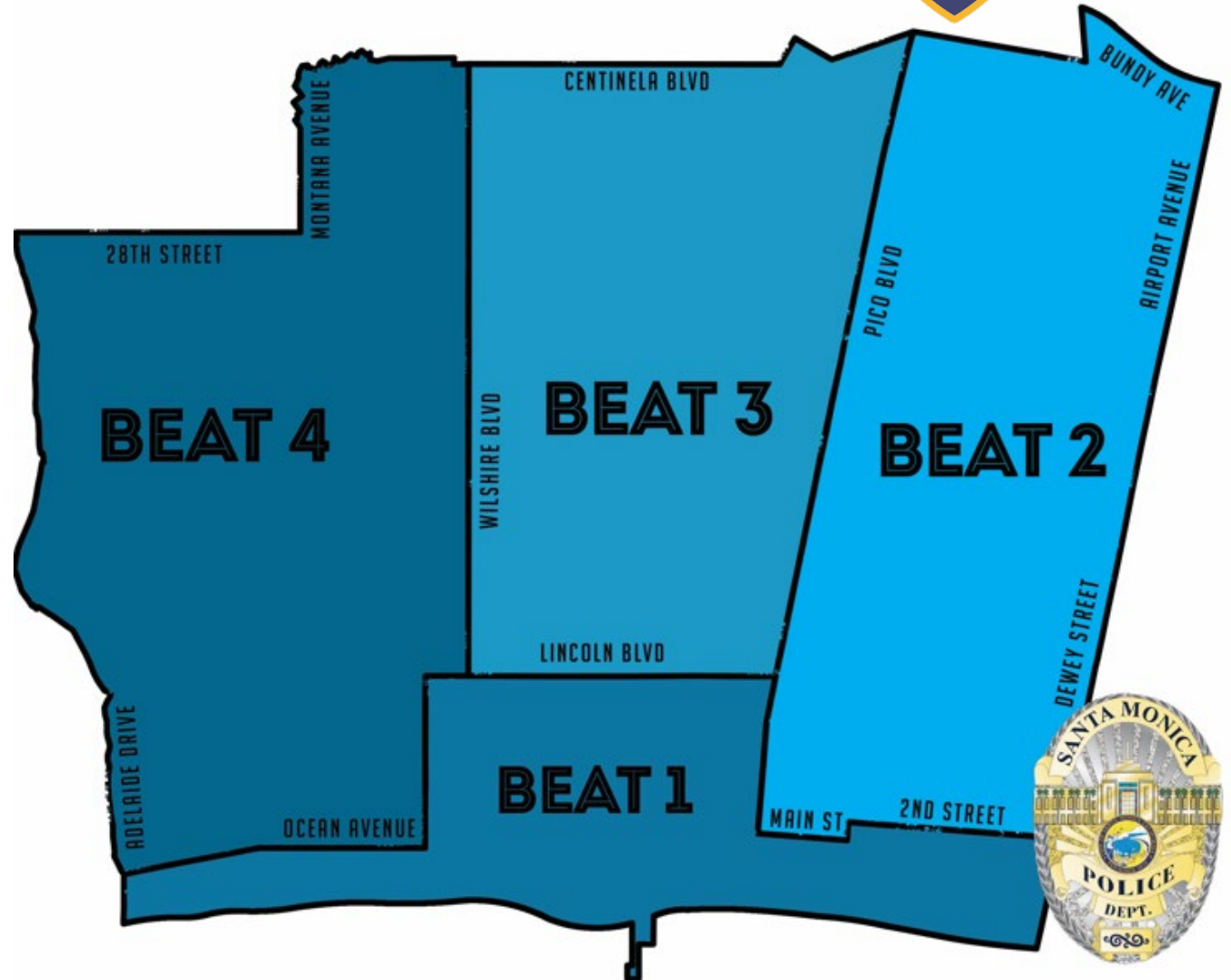

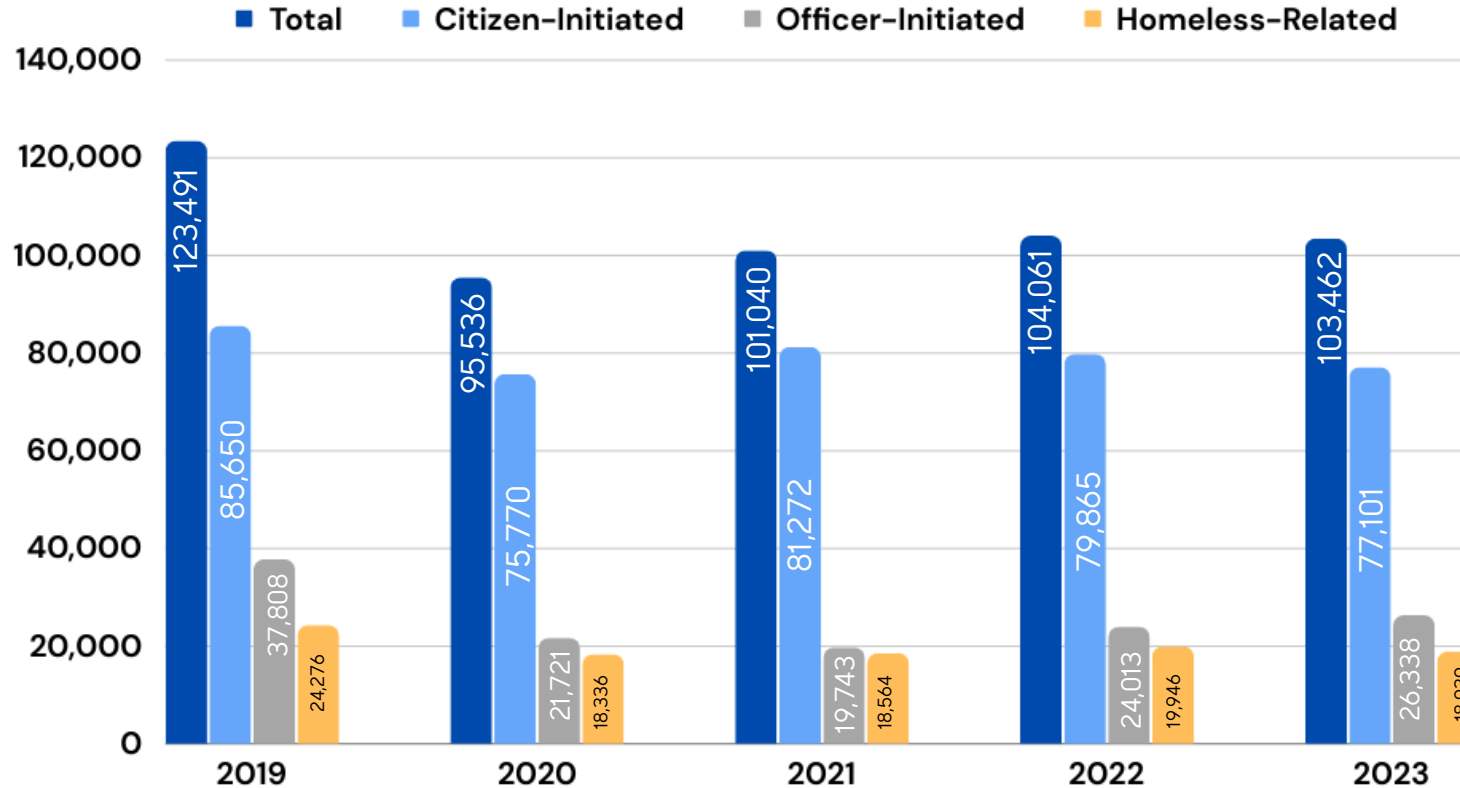

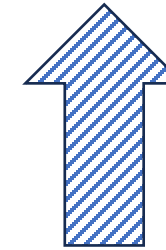




Calls for Service

In 2023, there was a 1% decrease in the number of calls for service received when compared to those in 2022.

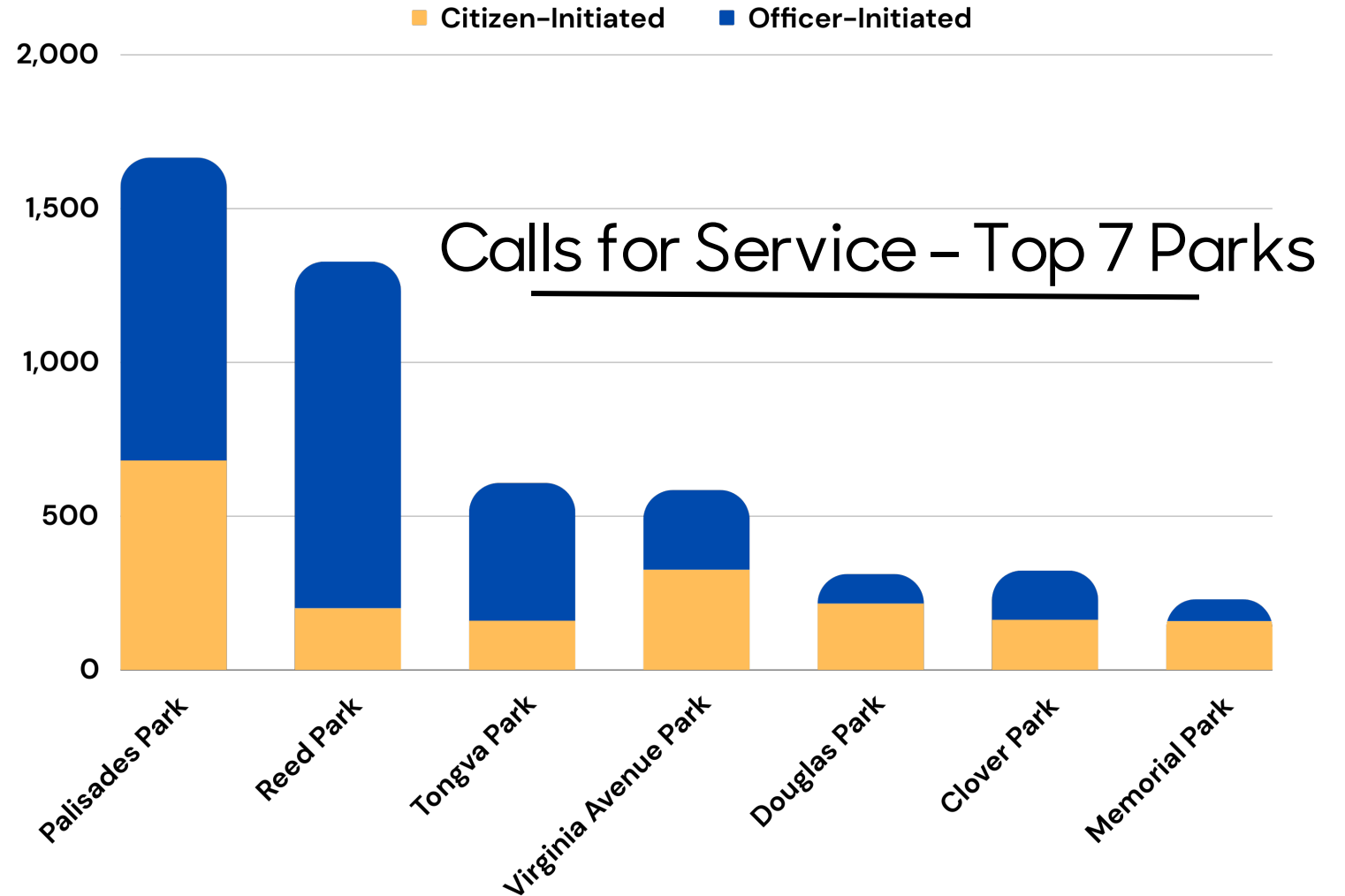
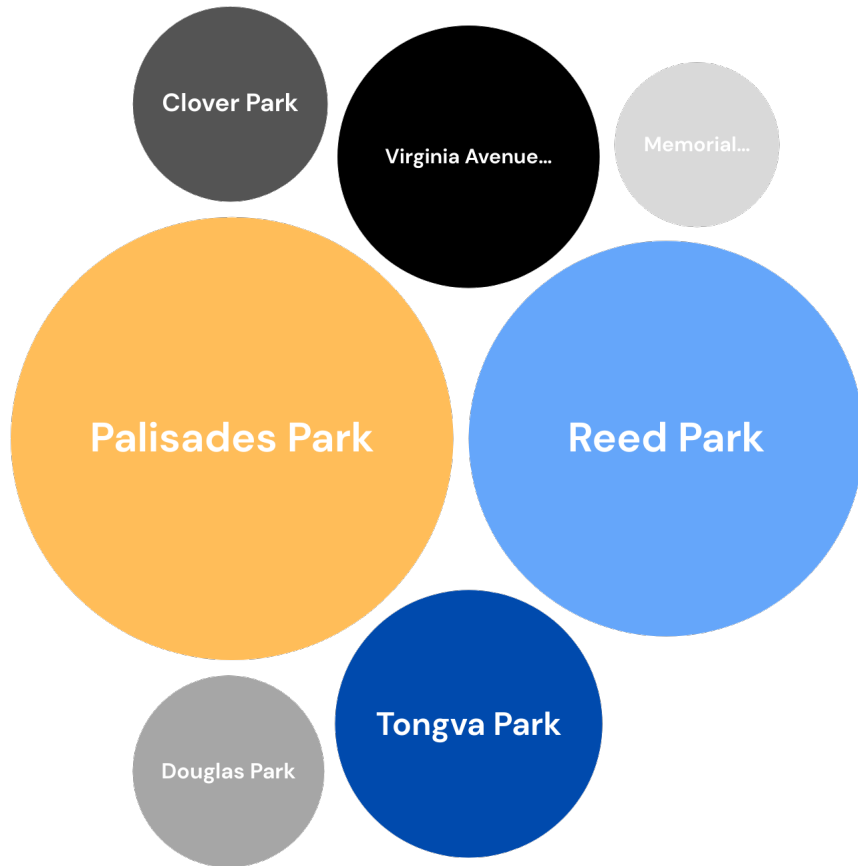
The number of citizen-initiated calls remained constant between 2021 and 2023.

Approximately 25% of all recorded service calls are initiated by officers in a proactive manner.

On average, dispositions related to homelessness account for 19% of all service calls.

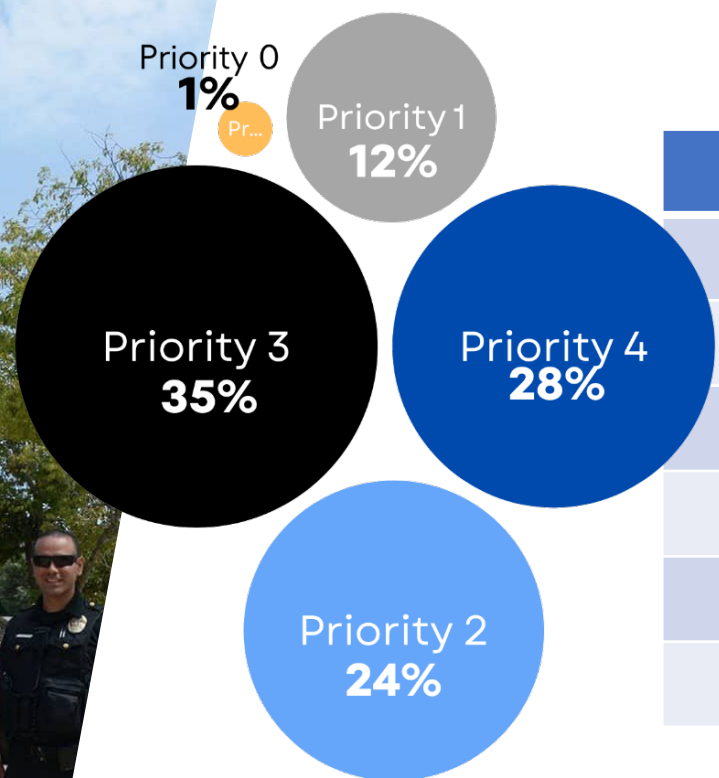

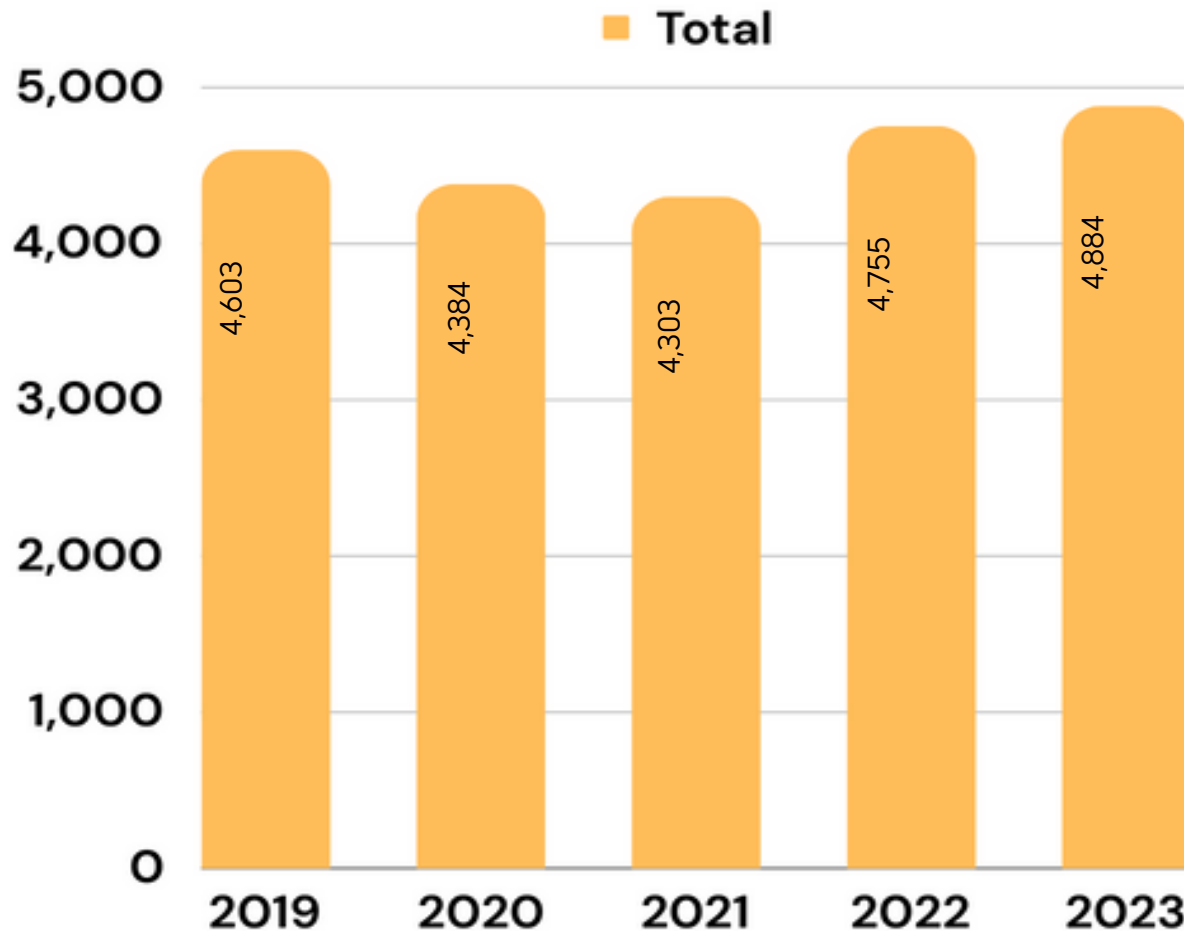

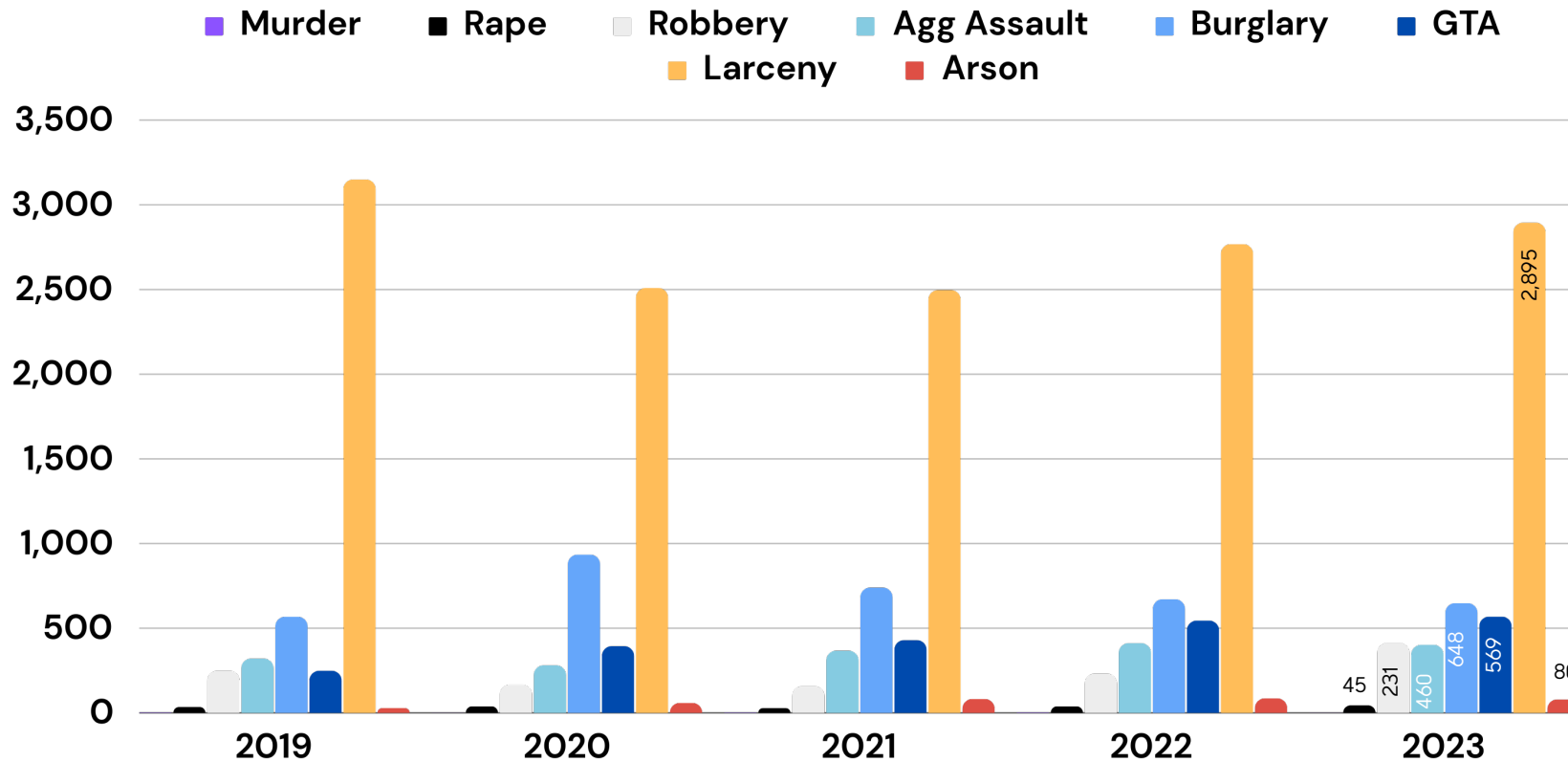

2023 Crime Stats – Part I



-  1 incident of Murder in 2023; Down from 3 in 2022
-  There were 45 rapes in 2023 with 39 in 2022.
-  Aggravated Assault levels had a slight decrease in 2023, compared to 2022.
-  While incidents of Robbery increased by a count of 9, strongarm robbery was the most likely offense. The use of firearms, knives and other weapons decreased.
-  Incidents of Arson decreased from 86 to 80 in 2023.

 GTA levels have consistently increased over the past five years. Hyundai was the most stolen model for the past two years, followed by Toyota. Kia thefts have spiked in the last two years.

 Cases of burglary peaked in 2020 and have since declined annually from 2021 to 2023 with a 3.4% decrease over 2022.

 Larceny was accountable for 59% of all Part I Crimes in Santa Monica in 2023.



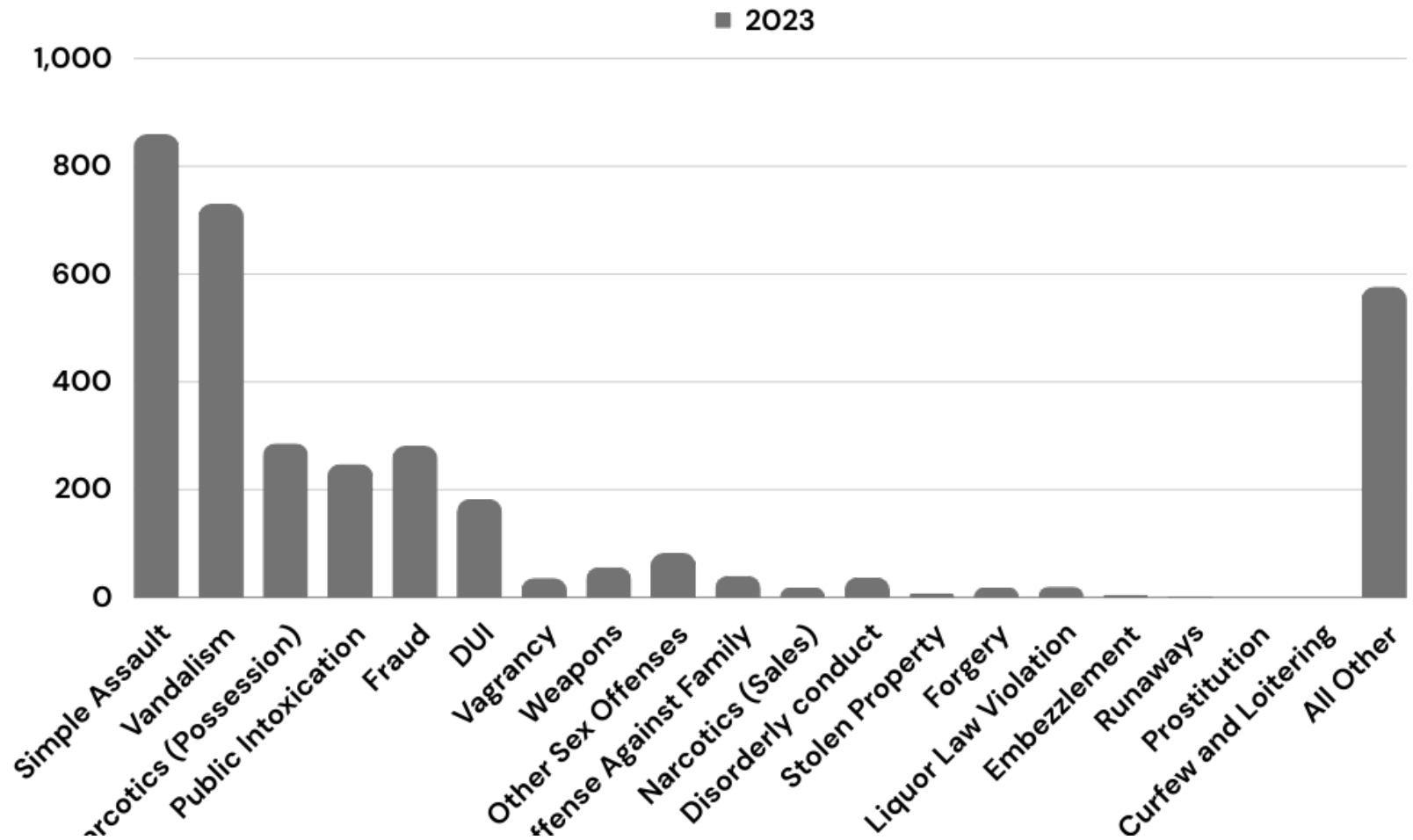
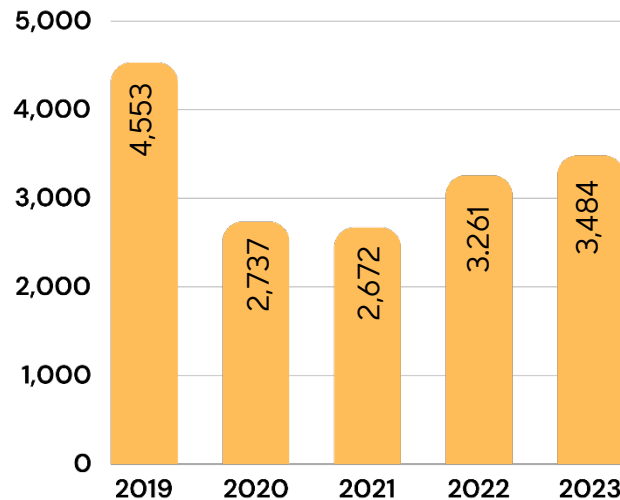

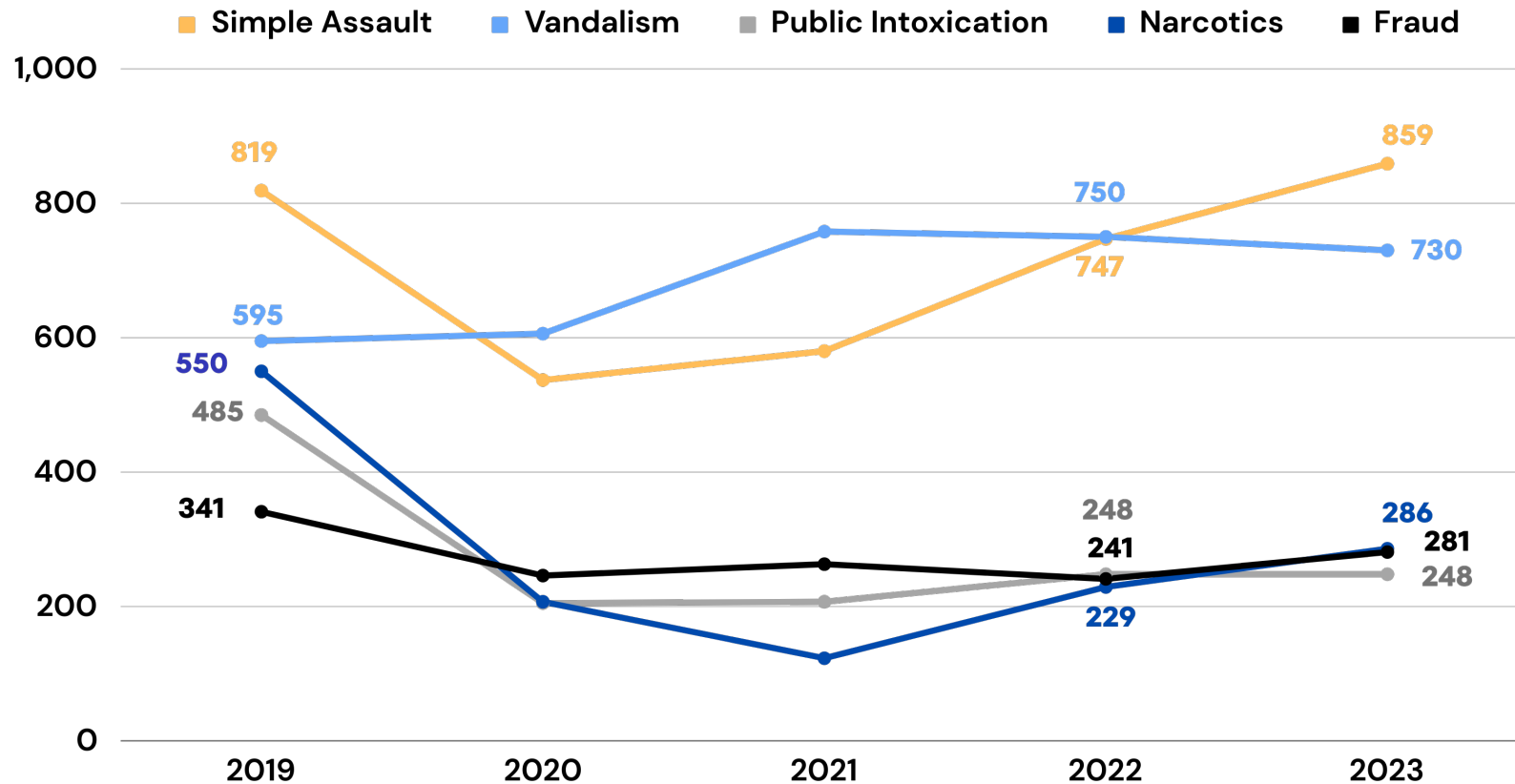

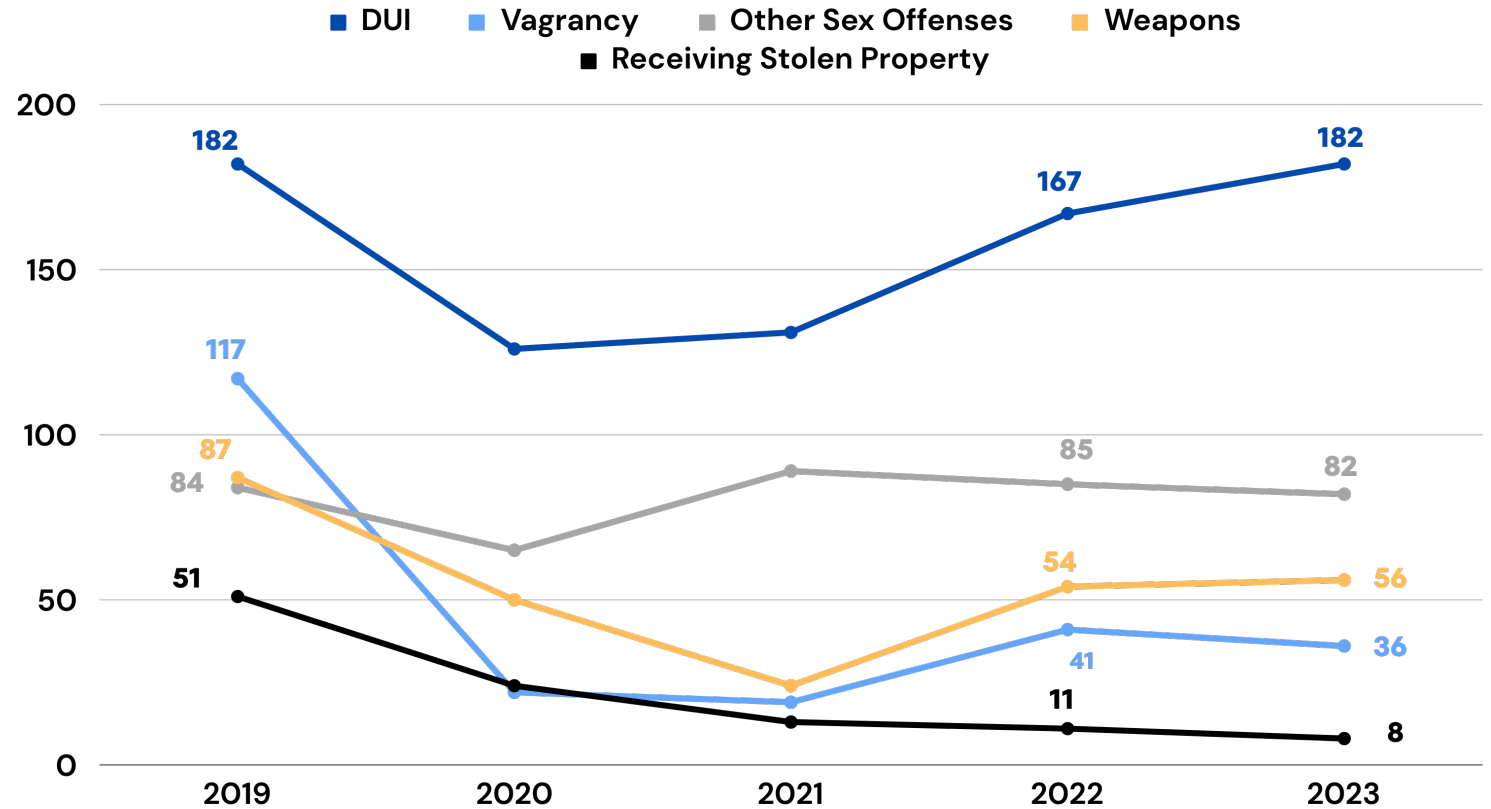
2023 Crime Stats – Part II cont.



- Simple Assaults** increased from 747 in 2022 to 859 in 2023. A 15% increase.
- Vandalism** declined 2.67% from 750 in 2022 to 730 in 2023.
- Public Intoxication** remained stable at 248 incidents in 2022 and 2023.
- Narcotics** increased from 229 incidents in 2022 to 289 in 2023 – a 25% increase.
- Fraud** increased 16.6% in 2022 (241 incidents) in comparison to 2023 (281 incidents)

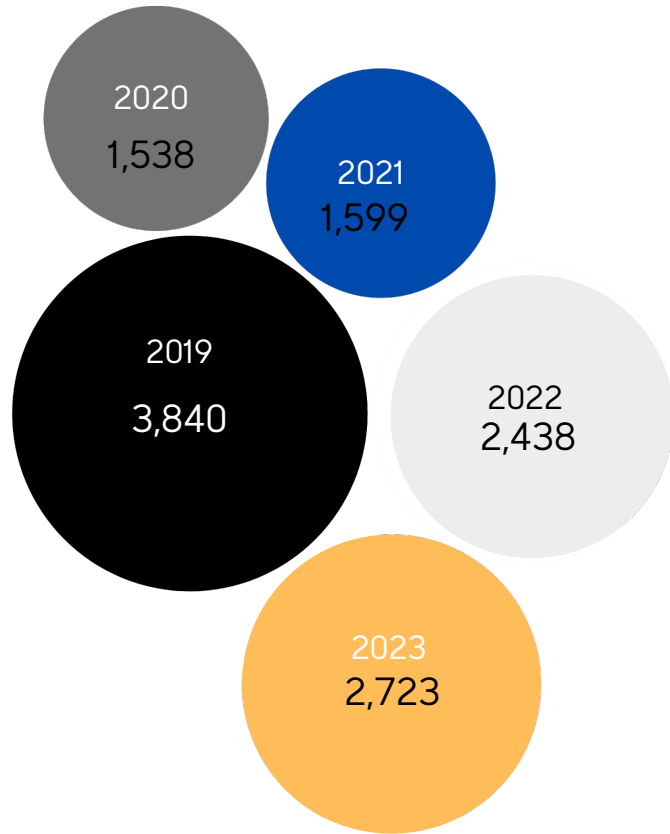

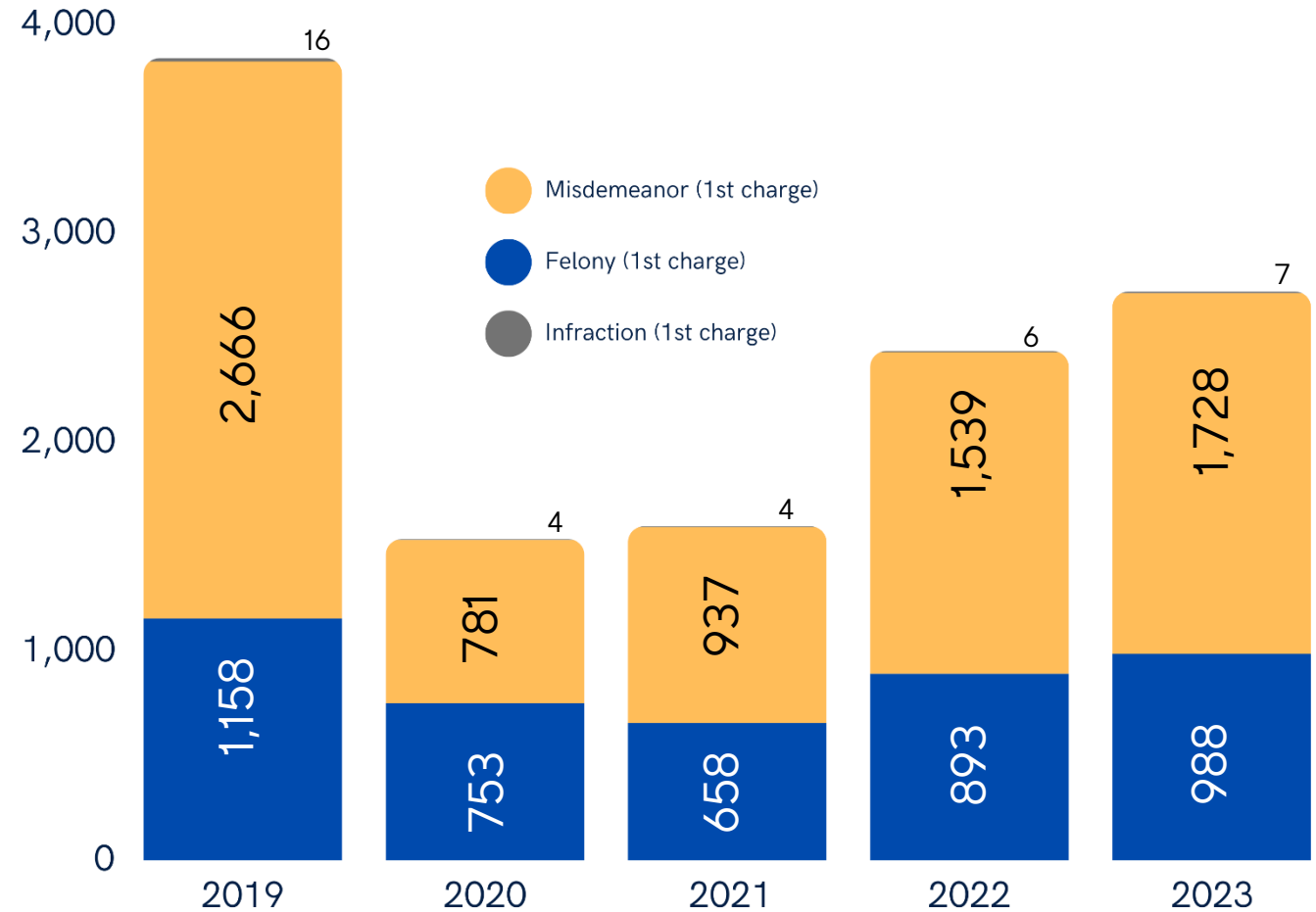

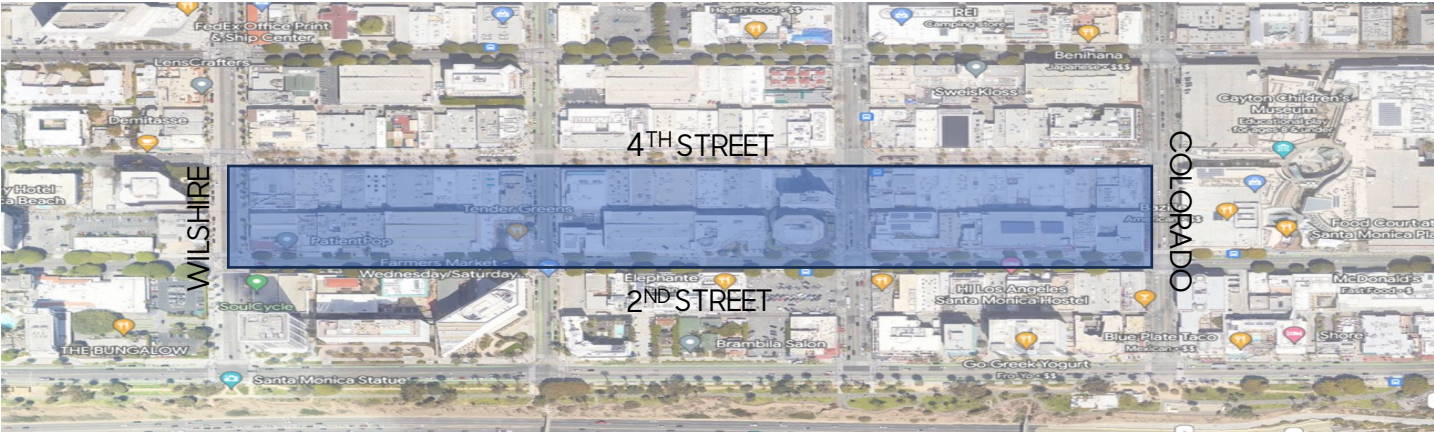
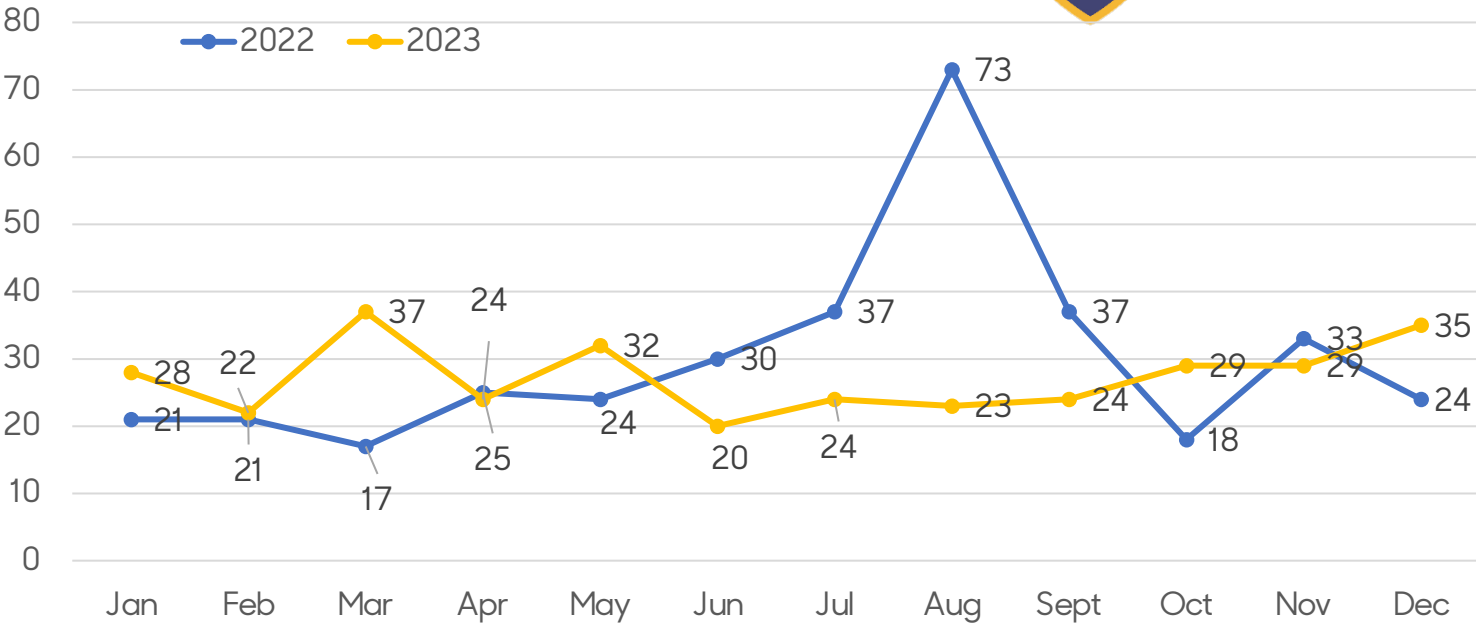


Promenade Part I Crime



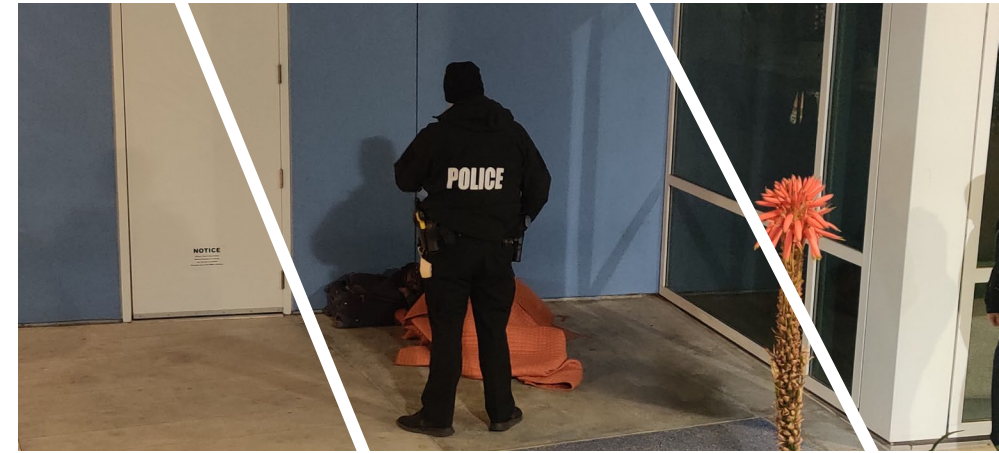
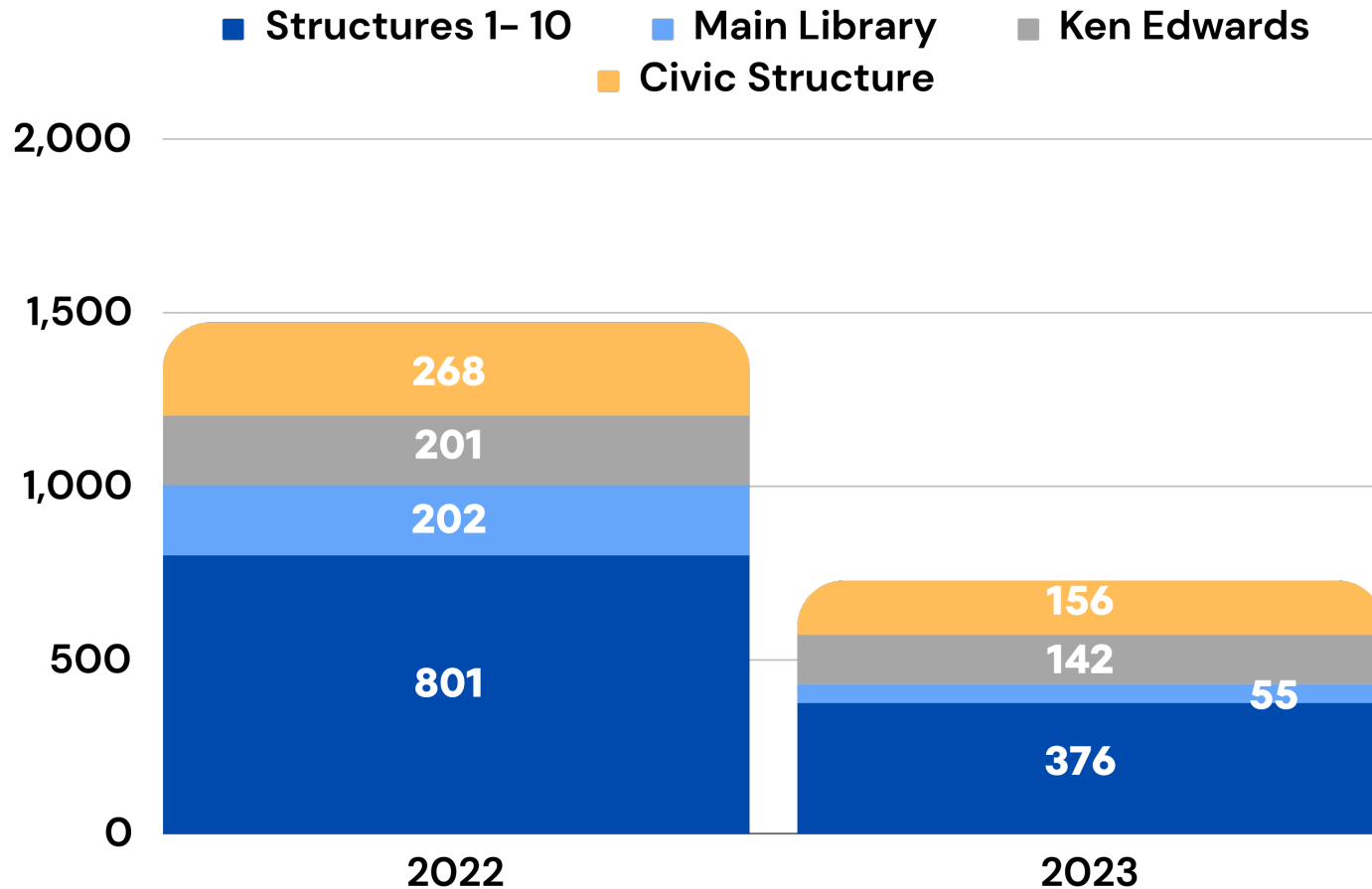
