Dear Neighbors:

The City of Santa Monica has contracted with International Line Builders (ILB) to install two (2) electric vehicle charging stations on Idaho Avenue between 6th Street and 7th Street. The stations will be located on the southside of Idaho Avenue near 6th Court. **Construction is expected to start April 1, 2024 and last through the end of April 2024. Work zone shown below.**



During the construction, temporary parking and sidewalk closures will occur. Safety barricades and signage will be provided at work locations. Driveway and building accesses will be maintained. Traffic flow will be maintained. Please note that the start and completion times/dates of the construction may change due to unforeseen conditions and weather.

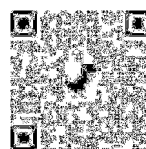
